

WEEKLY REPORT

11/8-11/14/09

On November 13th at 1:11 a.m., members of the Street Crime Unit observed a suspicious vehicle in the parking lot of the Howard Johnson's Hotel. The vehicle left the lot and was stopped by police when a traffic violation was observed. A front seat passenger was found to be wanted by Family Court for Failure to Appear. Female police officers discovered that two of three female rear seat passengers were found to have concealed drugs in their bras. A white pill was recovered from the purse of the third female. One of the females admitted to being a prostitute and has worked out of two Newark hotels. The male passenger was committed on a \$5,000 cash bail. Two of the three females were charged and released pending trial in court. The drugs recovered were found to be marijuana, cocaine, and clonazepam a schedule IV controlled substance.

On November 13th at 11:02 p.m., Officer James Spadola observed an individual break the exit gate at the Newark Parking Authority Lot #1. The suspect fled in a white Jeep Cherokee without paying the parking fee. The vehicle was stopped by Cpl. Sharpe and the driver was arrested for Driving Under the Influence. The driver stated that a friend of his broke the gate. An arrest warrant is pending for the individual who broke the gate.

On November 14th at 12:48 a.m., Sgt. Rieger observed a University of Delaware student repeatedly throwing his body against the glass window of a business located on Main Street. The student, who was intoxicated, was arrested and charged with disorderly conduct.

On November 15th at 2:15 p.m., Officer Vernon investigated an employee of a Main Street business who stole and used a customer's credit card. The incident was captured on video tape and charges are pending.

The Criminal Investigations Division is investigating two reported armed robberies that occurred within hours of each other. The first robbery occurred on November 17th at 10:33 p.m. on a service road between Nathan Hale Court and Ethan Allen Court. The second robbery occurred on November 18th at 2:35 a.m. on Prospect Avenue.
