

WEEKLY REPORT

1/24-1/30/10

Last week the suspect known as the “Shoe Burglar” was arrested by Newark Police Detective Fred Nelson. After recent burglaries and the subsequent press coverage, it was determined that the shoe burglar had been stealing shoes in Newark for approximately 20 years. Working from a description of a yellow Mitsubishi Eclipse provided by a witness to one of the burglaries, Detective Nelson was able to develop a suspect. Detective Nelson interviewed the suspect who admitted to being the “Shoe Burglar.” Three truckloads of stolen property were recovered from the defendant’s home. The property includes approximately 150 boxes of shoes and photographs. At this time, the defendant is charged with 25 counts of Burglary, 77 counts of Theft, and 15 counts of Criminal Mischief. Great work was performed by Detective Nelson in tracking the suspect and obtaining a confession.

The Newark Police Department completed its third annual Warrant Detail last week. The final number of people arrested was 78, who were wanted on 137 charges. Once again, thanks to the help and cooperation of the Newark Alderman Court and the University of Delaware Police Department made for a successful operation.

On Thursday, February 4th, Chief Tiernan, Captain Williams, and Lt. Hargrove will meet with the command staff and first line supervisors of University of Delaware Police Department to discuss areas in which the two police department can work together. Recently, Chief Ogden of the University of Delaware Police Department along with members of his staff met with Chief Tiernan and members of the Newark Police Department to discuss the same issue.
