

## WEEKLY REPORT

3/7-3/13/10

Detectives are investigating a sexual assault that occurred on North Chapel Street. A 21-year-old female victim reports that on Sunday, March 14<sup>th</sup>, she had been celebrating her birthday at two Main Street restaurants. At approximately 11:30 p.m., she was walking alone on North Chapel Street, when an unknown male picked her up, threw her over his shoulder and carried her into a house. The suspect carried her to a second floor bedroom and raped her. After the assault, the victim grabbed her clothes and ran from the house.

On Monday, March 15<sup>th</sup>, unknown suspects removed two iPods and a GPS from a car parked on McKean Place. On Tuesday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, unknown suspects removed a GPS and a MP3 Player from a car parked on East Main Street.

On Tuesday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, at 8:22 p.m., officers responded to the East Delaware Avenue Dart Transit Hub on a report of a subject who would not exit the bus. Upon arriving at the scene, officers observed a Newark resident who appeared to be sleeping. Attempts to wake the suspect were unsuccessful. During the course of the investigation, officers discovered the suspect was in possession of marijuana, heroin, and other illegal narcotics. The suspect was charged with possession of the drugs and possession of controlled substance within 1000 feet of a school.

Extra foot patrols were in place on Main Street on Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup>, and Wednesday March 17<sup>th</sup> for Saint Patrick's Day.

The New Castle County Office of Emergency Management is reviewing the City of Newark Emergency Management Plan. Upon completion of the review, the Newark plan will be updated by our Emergency Management Planning Committee.
