In recent weeks, numerous solicitors have been stopped in the city for soliciting door to door without a permit. This continues to be a problem in the city. On Wednesday, March 24th, while off-duty and on foot, Chief Tiernan observed two solicitors going door to door on Beagle Club Way. The chief notified police headquarters and CPL. Kendrick located the solicitors. One of the individuals was wanted on two warrants. The solicitor was arrested and turned over to the Department of Corrections at Gander Hill.

On Friday, March 26th, a resident of East Main Street reported that she gave a solicitor \$30.00 for a magazine subscription. The solicitor claimed to be selling magazines for the University of Delaware Broadcasting and Journalism school. The victim called the university to correct some information and was told that the university does not have a broadcast and journalism school.

On Monday, March 29th at 1:08 a.m., Cpl. Marsilii was conducting a property check of the Newark Shopping Center when he observed a vehicle driving through the rear parking lot by the cinema. Cpl. Marailii followed and stopped the vehicle for an equipment violation on East Main Street. The operator of the vehicle was arrested on warrants from two separate courts. The operator was also found to be in possession of 6 Schedule I Controlled Substance (pills), and 2 Schedule IV Controlled Substance (pills). The suspect was turned over to the Department of Corrections at Howard Young.

On Monday, March 29th at 2:06 a.m., two males dressed in black, smashed the glass door to State Line Cigarette Outlet. The suspects entered the store and removed approximately 30 to 50 packs of cigarettes from the rear wall. The suspects left the store at 2:08 a.m. The burglary was recorded on the security camera.
