The Knights of Columbus has recognized two Newark Police Officers as “Police Officer of the Quarter” for achievements that occurred during the third and fourth quarters of 2009. Detective Fred Nelson was recognized for his investigation of a murder that occurred in the city. Det. Nelson arrested and charged an individual for shooting a victim three times while inside of a hotel in Newark. Corporal Andrew Pagnotti was recognized for discovering a loaded handgun and 10 bags of marijuana during a traffic stop.

On Monday, April 19th, City Manager Kyle Sonnenberg promoted Gerald Bryda to the rank of Master Corporal. Master Corporal Bryda is a 12-year veteran of the Department and has served in patrol, criminal investigations, and the drug unit. He currently serves as the Crime Prevention and Crime Analysis Officer.

On Tuesday, April 20th, Detective Fred Nelson was honored as the Lion’s Club “Police Officer of the Year”. Det. Nelson was recognized for his investigation that led to the arrest of the suspect known as the “Shoe Burglar”.
