SUBJECT: Peeping/Lewdness Arrest

A Newark Police officer was conducting a property check of the Fairfield Shopping Center around 3:00 a.m. on Thursday May 13. While checking the back of the businesses, the officer saw a naked man running through the parking lot of an adjacent apartment complex, toward Fairfield Park. Officers searched the neighborhood, but were not able to find the person.

They did locate a car in the Fairfield Park parking lot. Visible inside the car on the passenger seat were men's clothing and sneakers. Other items in the car included a bra, four women's panties, and a pornographic magazine, and identification of the owner of the car. The car was towed from the lot.

Shortly after 7:00 a.m., residents in the 100 block of Delrem Drive reported a man dressed in only women's panties in their back yards, peering into windows. Officers arrived, located the man in the yard of one of the homes, and took him into custody.

He was charged with three counts Trespass with Intent to Peep, Lewdness, and Loitering. After an initial court appearance, he was released on an unsecured bond of \$500.
