On Wednesday, May 12th, Captain Williams attended the Weapons of Mass Destruction Committee Meeting of the Delaware Police Chief's Council. Captain Williams requested the committee fund a "Mobile Field Force" staffed by fifteen Newark Police Officers and fifteen University of Delaware Police Officers. The officers would be equipped and trained in crowd control techniques. The request for funding is currently being considered.

On Wednesday, May 12th, Chief Tiernan and Captain Potts attended a leadership training sponsored by the New Jersey Chiefs of Police Association.

The Newark Emergency Preparedness Plan continues to be updated with suggestions made by the New Castle County Office of Emergency Management. Once these revisions are completed, each department director and the AETNA Fire Department will be asked to update specific sections of the plan.

On Sunday, May 9th at approximately 1:20 a.m. a street robbery occurred on South College Avenue. The victim was walking northbound on S. College Avenue near Winslow Road when two suspects approached him. One of the suspects lifted his shirt and displayed a handgun that was tucked in his waistband. The suspects then demanded the victim's iPod, which he was listening to at the time of the encounter. The victim surrendered the iPod, then ran north on S. College Ave. The suspects were last seen fleeing westbound on Winslow Rd. Both suspects are black males, 18 to 20 years of age, with average to athletic builds. One was wearing a gray hoodie.
