**SUBJECT: Stabbing on Main Street**

On Saturday 06/05/2010 at approximately 2250 hours the Newark Police were called to Union Hospital in Elkton, Maryland for a report of a stabbing victim who sought treatment at that location. The victim is an 18 year old male from Elkton, MD. The victim reported that at approximately 2100 hours on 6/5/10 he was on East Main Street in the City of Newark Parking lot entrance located between Dunkin Donuts and California Tortilla, when a large fight broke out involving approximately 30 people. The victim stated that he was trying to pull someone away from the fight when he was stabbed with an unknown object in the left arm. The victim was transported to Union Hospital by friends. The victim was treated and released from the hospital. The victim is being uncooperative with investigators at this time.

The suspect is described as a white male wearing a black tank top, NFD.
