SUBJECT: Suspects in Credit Card Fraud

In late May 2010, the pictured suspects used stolen or cloned credit cards to make purchases at two businesses in the College Square Shopping Center, Newark. The suspects used fraudulent cards to purchase nearly \$950 worth of goods at Pep Boys, and then used another card to purchase nearly \$800 worth of items from K-Mart. One employee was able to see that the suspect had at least eight credit cards in his possession.

Both suspects are reported to be white males, possibly Hispanic, and in their mid 20's to early 30's. One is bald or has a cleanly-shaved head, and was wearing a blue t-shirt, khaki shorts, and white sneakers. The second has brown hair and was wearing a tan t-shirt with an unknown design or writing, and dark shorts.

The Newark Police Department has now received video surveillance footage of the suspects. Still photos and videos are attached. Any information about the suspects can be reported to Cpl.
