SUBJECT: Man Exposes Himself in Supermarket

An Indecent Exposure incident occurred in the Acme supermarket at 100 Suburban Drive, Newark, on Sunday June 27 around 9:50 p.m. A 40 year-old woman and her 9 year-old daughter were shopping in the store when a man walking past in an aisle them raised the leg of his shorts and exposed his genitals to the victims.

The mother notified store personnel, who called the police and prevented the suspect from leaving the store until an officer arrived to take him into custody.

Stevenson was charged with one count of Indecent Exposure 1st Degree, one count of Indecent Exposure 2nd degree, and one count of Lewdness. He was committed to the Young Correctional Facility in default of \$1,100 secured bond.
