SUBJECT: Attempt to Identify

During the overnight hours of July 9 into the morning hours of July 10, 2010, property was stolen from cars parked in the areas of Hearn Place and Hilltop Road in the Fairfield neighborhood in Newark.

Items stolen included a Pioneer car radio (model dchp3100ub), battery jumper cables, a large quantity of quarters, a black purse, and credit/debit cards.

The credit/debit cards were subsequently used at retail locations. The attached photos show an unknown white male who may be associated with the thefts. The vehicle in one of the photos is also possibly involved in the incident. The vehicle is believed to be a white or silver Nissan Pathfinder.
