

## WEEKLY REPORT

08/15-08/21/10

The five new “black and white” police vehicles have arrived. One vehicle is currently in service and the other four are waiting for the radio equipment to be installed. It is expected that the black and white color scheme on the police vehicles will help to make police patrols more visible to the public.

The Fall Crime Suppression located in concentrated patrol zones went into effect last weekend. No major incidents were reported in the downtown area. The Traffic Bureau is continuing with evening downtown road checks.

On Wednesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, installation will begin on the city downtown security camera system. The University of Delaware expects to complete the installation of their security camera system in time for the start of the fall semester. The combination of the two systems will enhance the security of the university campus, downtown, and the off campus housing areas.

On Wednesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, members of the Newark Police Department with the rank of sergeant and above met to review and discuss fall crime initiatives.

This week, four members of the patrol division completed “Bicycle Patrol” training offered by the Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control. We currently have five patrol officers certified for bicycle patrol. These officers will be patrolling on bicycle in the business and residential areas of the city.

The University of Delaware “freshman” move-in day is Saturday, August 28<sup>th</sup>. As usual, large crowds are expected on Main Street. Officers will be patrolling on foot to assist the public with any questions they may have. The mobile command post will be parked on Main Street. Numerous merchants have provided the Newark Police Department with coupons and fliers that will be available to the public in front of the command post. Downtown merchant maps will also be available to the public.
