

WEEKLY REPORT
09/05-09/11/10

On Thursday, September 9th, at 1:27 a.m., members of the Newark Police Department Street Crime Unit, observed an assault taking place in front of the Iron Hill Brewery. The male victim was lying on the ground, while the suspect punched him in the face. The plain clothes officers identified themselves as police officers and the suspect fled. After a brief foot pursuit, the suspect was arrested. The suspect was charged with Assault and Resisting Arrest.

On Friday, September 10th, at 1:28 a.m., a uniform police officer was approached by a citizen who reported there was a fight in front of Klondike Kates. The officer responded to the scene and separated a group of people. The male victim stated he was walking down the street when two people pulled his shirt over his head, pushed him to the ground, and began to beat him. Several witnesses observed the assault and tried to assist the victim. The two suspects ran from the officer and were arrested after a brief foot pursuit. The two were arrested and charged with Assault and Resisting Arrest.

During this past week, there were 58 alcohol related arrests. On Saturday, September 11th, at 1:21 a.m., officers responded to a house on Corbit Street to assist a student who had overdosed on alcohol. The female student was transported to Union Hospital. On Monday, September 13th, two pedestrians were injured after being struck by a vehicle on South Chapel Street. Both pedestrians had been drinking alcohol prior to darting into the street and being struck.

The Traffic Division has been conducting pedestrian education and enforcement in the downtown area. Over 200 summonses were issued for various violations. The number of traffic accident year-to-date in Newark, has been reduced by 80.

On Tuesday, September 14th, members of the Detective Division arrested a suspect involved in a previous robbery. The investigation is continuing.

On Friday, September 17th, Sgt. Mark Farrall will graduate from the FBI National Academy. Chief Tiernan, Capt. Potts, Lt. Simpson will attend the graduation ceremony in Quantico, VA.
