Chief Tiernan, Lt. Henry, and Charles Zusag completed the interview process on Wednesday, November 17th. A total of 39 police applicants were interviewed. The next phase in the applicant testing process is a physical agility exam which will be conducted on Saturday, November 27th.

The Patrol and Criminal Investigation Divisions are proactively working on a plan to combat residential burglaries over the holidays.

Crime statistics show that Part I serious crimes in Newark have been reduced by 27 while the number of calls for service have increased by 7,803 compared to this time last year.

Two applicants that applied for the position of Criminal Investigation Division Lieutenant were interviewed on Wednesday, November 17th. The newly selected CID Commander will replace Lt. Simpson. Lt. Simpson is retiring from the Newark Police Department and has accepted a position as Chief of Police for New Garden Township in Pennsylvania.
