The majority of the police department worked University of Delaware homecoming activities on Saturday, November 6<sup>th</sup>. There were dozens of arrests made for underage drinking, open alcohol containers, and disorderly premise. As of November 10<sup>th</sup>, we are still counting the exact number of arrests made.

The automatic license plate recognition system that was purchased through a state grant has been installed in one of the new police vehicles. Three video cameras that were also purchased through a state grant are being installed in other police vehicles.

Chief Tiernan, Lt. Henry, and Mr. Zusag have begun conducting interviews with police officer applicants. The interviews will conclude on Wednesday, November 17<sup>th</sup>. The next step in the police hiring process will be the physical agility test.

The outstanding success of the Newark Police Department Traffic Bureau's education and enforcement continues. The total number of motor vehicle accidents has been reduced by 133 from this date last year.

After twenty three years of dedicated service to the police department and citizens of Newark, Lt. Gerald Simpson has announced his retirement. Lt. Simpson has accepted a Chief of Police position with the New Garden Township in Pennsylvania. Lt. Simpson's last day of work with the Newark Police Department will be December 10<sup>th</sup>.
