

WEEKLY REPORT  
11/28-12/4/10

A fifteen year old suspect has been identified as the graffiti vandal using the tag "EDGE". The tag is painted at many locations of the east and south side of Newark as well as in county and state police jurisdiction. The juvenile has been charged and another graffiti suspect should be arrested in the near future.

On Monday, December 6<sup>th</sup>, at 9:25 a.m., officers responded to a report of suspicious persons on North Fawn Road. A resident observed two males in the rear of a house touching the window ledge of a neighbor's house. The resident called out to the suspects who stated they were looking for someone. The resident called the police with a description of the suspects. Corporal Marsillii searched the area and found the two suspects in the area of Patrick Henry Court. The suspects confessed to attempting to break into the house. They also confessed to another burglary in the area. This is a good example of how important it is for residents to call the police and report any suspicious activity no matter how minor it may seem.

On Tuesday, December 7<sup>th</sup>, unknown suspect(s) broke a basement window and entered a house on the 200 block of Cullen Way. The suspects stole thousands of dollars worth of jewelry. It appears that the incident occurred between 11:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. This is the second burglary to occur at the Hunt at Louviers in the past two weeks. In both incidents, entry was made through a basement window. Neighbors that were home at the time of the incident reported that they did not see or hear any suspicious activity.

On Tuesday, December 7<sup>th</sup>, a search warrant was executed at a local business regarding counterfeit National League Football clothing being sold. Over 300 counterfeit jerseys were recovered from the business. An additional 69 counterfeit jerseys were recovered at the suspect's residence. The suspect purchased the jerseys from China for \$20 each and then sold them for \$25 to \$65. The suspect cooperated with the investigation and the facts were reviewed by the Attorney Generals Office. The trademark infringement will be handled civilly.
