

WEEKLY REPORT  
12/05-12/11/10

On Friday, December 10<sup>th</sup>, at 3:33 p.m., a resident of McKean Place reported a burglary in progress at a neighbor's house. Officers arrived at the scene and surrounded the house. Several juveniles were found inside of the house and taken into custody. This is another great example of a resident reporting suspicious activity that lead to the arrest of burglars.

On Sunday, December 12<sup>th</sup>, officers responded to Christina Mill Drive on a report of physical domestic violence. A 27 year-old male was arrested for assaulting his girlfriend.

On Tuesday, December 14<sup>th</sup> at 2:37 a.m., officers responded to a request for assistance from the security officer at Porter Infiniti. Upon arriving at the scene, officers found the security officer questioning a suspicious male. After further investigation, the suspect was arrested and charged with possession of burglar's tools, attempted theft, trespassing, and possession of a fictitious license plate.

On Tuesday, December 14<sup>th</sup>, at 10:21 a.m., Cpl Robert Sharpe was on patrol in the area of Thompson Circle searching for suspicious activity. He observed an occupied vehicle parked in a driveway with the vehicle running. Due to burglaries in the area, Cpl. Sharpe checked the vehicle registration and found that the owner was wanted on a warrant from New Castle County. The officer approached the driver, identified him and took the suspect into custody. The suspect told the officer he had a loaded handgun in the glove box. The suspect has a valid permit to carry a concealed weapon. The suspect was turned over to the New Castle Police Department on the outstanding warrant.
