**SUBJECT: Armed Robbery of McDonalds**

The Newark Police Department is investigating an armed robbery that occurred on 1/11/11 at 10:33pm at the McDonalds located at 815 South College Avenue. In this incident the suspect entered the store, displayed a black long barrel revolver and demanded cash from the cashier. After receiving an undisclosed amount of cash the suspect then fled the restaurant, entered a vehicle (described below) and was last seen turning right out of the parking lot onto northbound South College Avenue.

The suspect is described as a black male, 5'8"-5'10", average build, 30 to early 40's with a mustache. He was wearing black sneakers, black jeans, a blue shirt under a black leather jacket, a knit hat, sunglasses, and cloth around his mouth.

The vehicle is described as an older model dark colored four door sedan, possibly with custom rims and window tint. The rear passenger window may have something on it such as a rain deflector or plastic bag.
