SUBJECT: Third subject arrested for involvement in Hunt at Louviers burglary

The Newark Police Department has identified and arrested a third subject for his involvement in one of two residential burglaries in the Hunt at Louviers development.

On November 30th, 2010 Newark Police investigated a daytime burglary which occurred in the 200 Block of Walker Way in the Hunt at Louviers development. In this burglary the suspect(s) gained entry to the residence by breaking a basement window and once inside stole a quantity of jewelry and prescription medication.
