

WEEKLY REPORT
03/20-03/26/11

Due to the University of Delaware spring break, this week has been relatively quiet for the police department.

During the course of officers' patrols, they have been proactively documenting crime prevention educational incidents. A couple examples are if an officer observes a garage door that is left open overnight, or a mobile GPS system on a dashboard of a vehicle a letter is mailed to the resident advising them that this action may result in becoming a victim of theft or other criminal activity.

On Monday, March 28th, at 6:43 p.m., Officer Hodge was dispatched to a theft of bicycle call. The bicycle was stolen from outside of Pizza U and the owner of the bike was following the suspect. Sergeant Aniunas observed the suspect at the intersection of Marrows Road and Wyoming Road. Upon seeing the police officer, the suspect jumped off the bike, fell to the ground and sustained a broken arm. The suspect appeared to be under the influence of alcohol, was given a breathalyzer test that registered .200 blood alcohol content. A criminal check revealed the suspect had 10 outstanding warrants. The suspect was transported by Aetna to Christiana Hospital. Upon his release from the hospital, the suspect was charged with theft and driving under the influence of alcohol. He was committed to the George Hill Correctional Facility.

Five new police recruits began work this week. Two of the recruit positions are being funded by a Department of Justice, Office of Community Policing grant. The grant funding is for three years.

On Thursday, March 31st, Chief Tiernan, Captain Potts, and Captain Williams will meet with University of Delaware Police Administrative staff to discuss on going police operations.

The seven new downtown security cameras and fixed mount license plate recognition system camera have been installed. This will double out ability to search for criminal activity in the downtown area.
