

## WEEKLY REPORT

03/06-03/12/11

There has been a rash of thefts from vehicles on the west side of the city. In almost each event, items were taken from unlocked vehicles. Residents are strongly urged to lock their vehicles at night and not leave valuables in them. Recent thefts occurred on Vassar Drive, Fiske Lane, and Briar Lane between March 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>.

On Saturday, March 12<sup>th</sup> at 1:31 a.m., officers were on patrol on Delaware Avenue when they observed a 25 year-old male, walking through the parking lot of 7-11. The officers further observed the suspect adjust his pants to reveal a handgun concealed under his jacket. The suspect was arrested and charged with public intoxication and possession of a concealed firearm. The suspect was released after posting \$3,000 bail.

Motor and foot patrols were increased on Saturday, March 12<sup>th</sup> in anticipation of early Saint Patrick's Day celebrations. A total of 15 alcohol and drug related arrests were made throughout the day. Several large and loud parties were dispersed.

On Tuesday, March 15<sup>th</sup> at 1:18 a.m., Corporal Vernon was on patrol in the area of Elkton Road and Amstel Avenue. The officer observed a vehicle being driven without operating tail lights. The vehicle was stopped and the 19 year-old driver was subsequently arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol.

On Tuesday, March 15<sup>th</sup> at 1:45 a.m., Corporal Conover was on patrol in the area of Elkton Road and Casho Mill Road. The officers observed a vehicle travelling south bound in the north bound lane. The vehicle was also weaving as it travelled. The officer stopped the vehicle and arrested the driver for possession of marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia, and driving under the influence of drugs.

A Traffic Committee meeting was held on Tuesday, March 15<sup>th</sup>. Representatives of DELDOT gave a presentation of proposed changes to South College Avenue/Route 896 and Old Chestnut Hill Road. Several residents attended the meeting and voiced their opposition to the proposed changes. In addition, signed petitions from other area residents, who are opposed to the project, were given to the DELDOT representative. The Traffic Committee voted unanimously against the proposed changes and provided alternatives/suggestions for DELDOT to consider.
