

WEEKLY REPORT
02/20-02/26/11

A number of police calls this week were alcohol related.

On Thursday, February 24th, at 10:07 p.m., Corporal Sharpe and Officer Barnes responded to a rental home on East Cleveland Avenue. Upon arriving at the scene, the officers spoke with a 22 year-old female victim. The victim stated that she was in her bedroom when the suspect, an 18 year-old female, knocked on the bedroom door asking to speak with the victim. When the suspect entered the room she repeatedly punched the victim in the head and shoved her into furniture. A witness was able to separate the two, placing the suspect in another bedroom. The victim then went into that bedroom and instructed the suspect to leave the house. The suspect pointed a knife at the victim and said "Don't mess with me I'm drunk". The suspect was charged with aggravated assault, offensive touching, and underage consumption of alcohol. The suspect was released after posting \$2,100 bond.

On February 26th, at 12:14 a.m., Master Corporal Nelson responded to East Cleveland Avenue on a report of loud music. Upon arriving at the scene, the officer heard music coming from the basement. The officer looked through the basement window and observed a crowd of people. The crowd was dispersed and the renter was issued a summons for disturbing the peace.

On Saturday, February 26th, at 1:10 a.m., Corporal Vernon was conducting radar speed enforcement in the area of Newark High School. The officer observed a vehicle travelling 42 MPH in a 25 MPH zone. The vehicle was stopped in the College Square parking lot. When speaking with the driver of the vehicle, the officer detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage on the driver's breath. The driver stated he had just left Mojo's on East Main Street where he had consumed three beers. After a series of tests that determined he was under the influence of alcohol, the driver was arrested. A breath sample was taken at police headquarters which revealed the driver had a blood alcohol content of .143%. The driver was charged with driving under the influence of alcohol and speeding. He was released to his father.

On Saturday, February 26th, at 1:36 a.m., Corporal Sharpe responded to a motor vehicle accident on Library Avenue. The driver of one of the vehicles was wearing a wristband from Grotto's Restaurant. The driver stated he had consumed two 25 ounce beers at Grotto's prior to becoming involved in the accident. After a series of tests the driver was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. A breath sample taken at police headquarters revealed a blood alcohol content of .167%.

On Saturday, February 26th, at 2:12 a.m., Corporal Schwagel responded to a report of a fight in the area of East Main Street. Upon arriving at the scene, the officer did not observe a fight, however did observe approximately 20 people standing by one of the apartments being loud. The officer could also hear loud music coming from inside the apartment. The officer dispersed the group outside of the apartment, and then contacted the tenants. Both tenants of the apartment were issued a summons for disturbing the peace.

On Sunday, February 27th, at 12:17 a.m., officers responded to the area of West Park Place on a report of excessive noise. Upon arriving at the scene, officers observed a loud disorderly crowd leaving a residence. A car was parked on the front lawn of the property and several tables were set up in the driveway. The tables were covered with red cups containing alcohol. The tenant was issued a summons for disorderly premises and underage consumption of alcohol. As guests were leaving the party, a fight broke out on West Park Place and Orchard Road. Corporal Conover observed two males fighting on the ground and several more who ran off as police arrived. The two suspects were both charged with disorderly conduct.

On Monday, February 28th, at 11:42 p.m., Corporal Beighley responded to East Delaware Avenue on a report of a male exhibiting disorderly behavior and attempting to fight pedestrians. Officer Fountain arrived at the scene and observed the male shouting obscenities at people and telling them how he would harm them. The suspect was placed under arrest. When he was placed in the rear of the patrol car, the suspect began to head-butt the rear plastic prisoner barrier. The suspect was charged with disorderly conduct.

On Monday, February 28th, a suspect was arrested for the robbery of Blockbuster Video that occurred on Tuesday, February 15th. The suspect was committed to the Howard Young Correctional Facility.

On Tuesday, March 1st, at 10:40 p.m., Master Corporal Maiura responded to an apartment on Lehigh Road on a report of a person who had fallen and injured his head. Upon arriving at the apartment, the officer was informed by the reporting person that she and two others had been out drinking. Upon arriving back at the apartment, one of the victims fell getting out of the car and struck his head. The victim was able to get into the apartment where he vomited and again fell striking his head and falling unconscious. A second victim passed out on the couch and could not be awakened. Both victims were transported to the hospital by ambulance.
