SUBJECT: Search warrant results in arrest and seizure of marijuana

The Newark Police Department has arrested Jarrett T. Husid, a University of Delaware student from Hopewell New Jersey for multiple drug charges following an investigation and search warrant of his local residence at 201 Courtney Street, Newark, DE.

On Friday, April 8th members of the Newark Police Department's Special Investigations Unit initiated a search warrant of Husid's residence. During the search warrant officers uncovered a small marijuana grow operation in the basement of the residence and seized approximately 12 pounds of marijuana valued at over \$50,000. Officers also seized potting soil, grow lights and other items related to the grow operation along with supplies to package the marijuana for distribution. Husid was found to have a variety of grades/strands of marijuana all packaged for sale and there were indications that Husid also accepted delivery of marijuana from outside sources.

Husid was out of town during the search warrant but later turned himself in to authorities. He was arrested and released after posting a \$32,000 cash bail.

- **Possession of Marijuana**
- **Possession of Drug Paraphernalia**

The Newark Police Department affirms that all defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
