**SUBJECT: March 10<sup>th</sup> 7-11 Robbery Arrest**

The Newark Police Department has arrested Thomas Bartley, Jr. of Newark for the March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011 Robbery of the 7-11 store located at 202 Elkton Road. Police obtained warrants for his arrest following an investigation initiated by a Crime Stoppers tip.

On April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2011 Bartley was contacted on an unrelated incident by a Newark Police Patrol Officer who recognized him as a wanted person. Bartley was taken into custody without incident and charged with one count of Robbery 1<sup>st</sup> Degree. He was later committed to Howard Young Correctional in lieu of \$10,000 secured bail.
