

## WEEKLY REPORT

03/27-04/02/11

On Friday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, at 11:40 p.m., members of the Newark Police Department Street Crime Unit, observed a suspicious vehicle on East Main Street. The vehicle was stopped after it was observed committing a traffic violation. A stolen handgun was found in the vehicle. One occupant was charged with two traffic violations, a second occupant was arrested on a warrant for violation of probation, and failure to appear in court, a third occupant was arrested for criminal impersonation, and several warrants, the fourth occupant was arrested for receiving a stolen firearm, carrying a concealed deadly weapon, possession of marijuana, as well as other charges.

On Saturday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>, at 2:15 a.m., Master Corporal Nelson and Sergeant Simpson responded to the Woods of Louviers on a report of a suspicious vehicle. Upon arriving in the development, M/Cpl Nelson observed a sports utility vehicle. The officer activated his emergency lights and pulled in front of the suspicious vehicle. The vehicle swerved around the police car and turned onto Odessa Way. The officer turned his vehicle around and proceeded onto Odessa Way. M/Cpl. Nelson located the vehicle abandoned at the cul-de-sac of Odessa Way. The vehicle was still running with the keys in the ignition. The area was searched and Officer Mease located a subject exiting the woods in the area of Cook Way. The subject, who was intoxicated, was arrested and taken to police headquarters. He was charged with Resisting Arrest and Disregarding a Police Officer signal. The investigation is continuing with an attempt to identify the other occupants of the vehicle.

On Wednesday, April 6<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 a.m., Corporal Beighley was investigating a motor vehicle accident on Elkton Road. The officer discovered that one of the drivers had an outstanding arrest warrant. The suspect was taken into custody.

In the near future, the Traffic Bureau will begin a pedestrian education and enforcement program in the downtown area.
