On Saturday, April 23rd, at 10:53 a.m., Officer Mease responded to the Pathmark store located in the College Square Shopping Center on a report of a shoplifting. The vehicle did not display a registration tag. Video of the suspects was recovered from the store and released to the media.

The victim, a 35 year-old female, stated she was walking from her car to the entrance of the store, when she was approached by a male trying to tie a white t-shirt around his face.
