

## WEEKLY REPORT

05/01-05/07/11

On Wednesday, May 4, 2011 at approximately 2:55 a.m., PFC Stevens responded to the unit block of Choate Street for a report of disorderly conduct. A victim had been assaulted by two suspects after he confronted them about urinating in front of his female friends. The victim and the suspects fought two separate times in the driveway to the residence. The suspects reportedly fled the area and then returned later with a third suspect. The suspects entered the victim's house and attempted to fight the victim again. The victim received scratches to his chest, shoulders and scalp. The victim refused medical treatment. Officers were able to obtain identifying information for the suspects; however, the victim did not wish to pursue charges.

On Thursday, May 5, 2011, Officer Andres took a late report of a fraud which occurred at the WSFS bank in College Square. The victim reported that on Friday April 1, 2011 he was approached by a white male suspect when he was entering the bank. The suspect stated that he needed the victim's assistance in cashing a check. The victim stated that the suspect offered him \$60 to cash a \$630 check. The victim cashed the check against his account and gave the suspect his money. Several weeks later the bank charged the victims account the \$630 because the check was fraudulent. The victim then reported the incident to Newark Police after he was contacted by a Detective from the Queen Anne County, Maryland Sheriff's Office. The Detective was investigating a burglary in which a checkbook was stolen and numerous checks were fraudulently cashed throughout Maryland and Delaware. Charges will be lodged against a suspect once all evidence is received from Queen Anne County.

On Saturday, May 7, 2011 at approximately 1:54 a.m., Cpl. Sharpe responded to the first block of North Chapel Street for a report of a fight in a third floor apartment involving three to ten subjects. Upon arrival to the area, a victim was located in the Newark Shopping Center suffering from lacerations and swelling to the face. The victim was transported to the hospital by ambulance. It was determined that during an altercation the victim was punched, causing him to fall down a fire escape. Some possible suspects were identified, the investigation is ongoing.

On Sunday, May 8, 2011 at approximately 4:27 a.m., Cpl. Pagnotti responded to the area of Panorama Drive for a report that suspects threw bricks and rocks at multiple parked vehicles in the neighborhood damaging them. As Cpl. Pagnotti was speaking with victims, a dark colored sedan sped by with no lights on and ran through a stop sign at a high rate of speed. As officers began to check the area they noticed that a lawn had been damaged by the vehicle leading them to the area of Woodsman Drive. The vehicle was located parked in a driveway with four suspects feigning sleep inside. All four suspects were taken into custody without incident. Located in the vehicle was alcohol, a black bandana mask and an air soft BB gun that resembled a Glock pistol. The 17 year old driver was charged with DUI, driving without headlights, running a stop sign, violating license provision due to age, speed greater than reasonable, reckless driving, aggressive driving, malicious mischief by a motor vehicle and underage drinking. The ages of the three other suspects are 19 years old and two are 16 years old. All four will also be charged with four counts each of: Criminal Mischief, Conspiracy, Resisting Arrest and Trespassing.
