

WEEKLY REPORT

The Newark Police Department has arrested 21 year old Jaron Starkey of Wilmington for Trafficking PCP and several weapons offenses following the investigation of a domestic dispute in Newark on June 7, 2011. At approximately 9:15 a.m. an officer on patrol was alerted by a passerby to a possible domestic dispute on Willa Road in Newark. The officer responded to the area and observed Starkey involved in a domestic dispute with his 26 year old girlfriend. As the officer approached he observed Starkey drop an unknown item onto the ground. Starkey was taken into custody for questioning and it was discovered that the dropped item was a bottle containing liquid PCP. It was also learned that during the domestic dispute, which started in an apartment in the 100 block of Thorn lane, that Starkey had punched his girlfriend in the face, broken the window out of her vehicle and stolen her laptop computer. The girlfriend was uninjured during the altercation.

Following the discovery of the PCP, officers initiated a search warrant at Starkey's home. During this search officers recovered a second bottle containing a small amount of liquid PCP, two handguns, one with an obliterated serial number, and ammunition for the weapons.

Starkey was arrested on the below charges and transported to Howard R. Young Correctional in lieu of \$91,500 secured bail.
