On Wednesday, July 6, 2011, Cpl. Conover responded to Rockmoss Avenue for a report of a residential burglary. Cpl. Conover learned that while the victim was at work his garage was broken into. An all terrain vehicle, several tools and power equipment were stolen. The value of the stolen property is valued at approximately \$2,000.00. Evidence was collected at the scene by Cpl. Schwagel. There are currently no suspects in this case. The case has been turned over to detectives for additional investigation.

On Thursday, July 7, 2011, Officer Wolfrom responded to Tyre Avenue for a report of a theft. Officer Wolfrom contacted the owner of a residence who reported that the exterior air conditioner condenser unit had been stolen. The theft occurred sometime between June 23, 2011 and July 7, 2011. The condenser is valued at \$1,250.00. The same residence was also a victim of a theft of copper piping earlier in the year. There are currently no suspects. The case has been turned over to detectives for additional investigation.

On Thursday, July 7, 2011, Officer Smith responded to North Street for a report of a residential burglary. The victim had left the residence at approximately 10:00 p.m. and returned just after midnight to discover the burglary. The victim reported leaving the residence and it was believed to be all locked up. Upon returning to the house, the victim immediately noticed that a lap top computer was missing from the living room. As the victim continued to search the residence, it was determined that a television, jewelry and other items were missing. It is unknown how the suspect entered the residence. There are currently no suspects. This case has been turned over to detectives for additional investigation.

On Sunday, July 10, 2011, Officer Andres responded to Center Street for a report of an occupied residential burglary. The victim reported that while asleep in an upstairs bedroom, the victim heard a sound as if someone was walking around the first floor. When the victim went to investigate the sound, it was immediately observed that the side door to the residence was ajar. The victim then noticed that two lap top computers and an iPod were missing. The victim stated that the doors to the residence were not locked. No suspects were located.
