

WEEKLY REPORT

On Thursday, July 14, 2011, Officer Spadola responded to the 300 block of South College Avenue for a report that a paving company was paving the person's driveway without their consent. The company, "White's Custom Paving" had solicited the elderly resident earlier in the day and the resident refused the offer to pave the driveway. The resident then left for a few hours and upon return, the company was paving the driveway. It was determined that there was no signed contract and the resident did not consent. The owner of the company, Isaac Forrest, was arrested due to the fact that he has a court imposed No Contact order with anyone over the age of 62 for home improvement work. Forrest was also arrested for soliciting in the city without a permit.

On Thursday, July 14, 2011, PFC Barnes responded to the Christiana Hospital Emergency Room for a report of an assault incident that had occurred earlier in the development of White Chapel. It was determined that two subjects, a 14 year old juvenile and 30 year old adult, were walking on White Chapel Drive when they were approached by a 14 year old and 16 year old, whom the other 14 year old juvenile had been having problems with. The 14 and 16 year olds then approached the other two and instigated a fight. The 16 year old pulled off his shirt, had a chain wrapped around one hand and a knife in the other, he then went after the 30 year old. During the attack, the 30 year old was able to strike the 16 year old several times and throw him into a tree which stopped the attack. The 16 year old attacker was later transported to the hospital after passing out and suffered from a concussion and a fractured back. Detectives were called out to investigate the incident and determine appropriate charges.

On Friday, July 15, 2011, Officer Wolfrom responded to the first block of North Chapel Street for a report that a subject was knocking on resident's doors, then trying the handles and walking around the rear of the houses. Dispatchers were able to watch the suspect on the downtown camera system and advise responding officers of his exact location. Sean Hendricks was taken into custody and charged with trespassing. Hendricks claimed to be soliciting for lawn cutting; however most of the house had no grass.

On Friday, July 15, 2011, Cpl. Dawson responded to Meriden Drive in Fairfield for a report of an elderly victim of a phone scam. The victim had been involved in a phone scam years ago. The caller referenced this incident and stated that the person was arrested and that they were now entitled to their money back and a new car which was won in the contest years ago. However, the caller said that the taxes must be paid on the car before it could be delivered. The victim sent a \$4,000.00 check to an address in Michigan. This case is being referred to the Attorney General's Office.
