

WEEKLY REPORT

On Thursday, July 21, 2011 at approximately 12:09 p.m., M/Cpl. Simpson responded to the Home Depot in Suburban Plaza for an attempted theft and fraudulent use of a credit card. Upon arrival the loss prevention manager stated that they had received a phone in order for hardwood flooring and a lawn tractor totaling \$6,083.00. A flag went off in Home Depot's computer system because this transaction was similar to numerous others in Virginia, West Virginia and Maryland. A hauling company arrived to Home Depot to pick up the items, which had been hired by the unknown suspect. The card used was deemed to be fraudulent and the items did not leave the store. This case has been turned over to detectives for additional investigation.

On Thursday, July 21, 2011, Cpl. Vernon responded to the first block of Thompson Circle for a report of a residential burglary which occurred during the daytime hours. The suspect broke into the residence through a rear window. Stolen from the house was a guitar, cash and prescription medications. Detectives responded to the scene to assist in the investigation. A suspect in the burglary has been developed and an arrest is pending additional investigation.

On Saturday, July 23, 2011, Officer Hodge responded to the first block of Westfield Drive for a report of a residential burglary that had just been discovered by the homeowner. Cpl. Jones and K9 Paco also responded to check the residence for the intruder, with negative results. The suspect broke into the residence during the evening hours and removed jewelry, cash, gaming systems, clothing and prescription medications. This case will be forwarded to detectives for additional investigation.

On Sunday, July 24, 2011 at approximately 12:48 a.m., Cpl. Vernon and additional officers from NPD and UDPD responded to the 100 block of E. Cleveland Avenue for a report a large fight involving up to 100 people. It took multiple officers from both agencies to clear the crowds. Officers then observed a group of people tending to someone on the ground. The 23 year old male victim was located lying on the front lawn of a residence with blood covering his head and face. An ambulance was called and he was transported to Christiana Hospital. The victim suffered several lacerations to the face, an orbital fracture, a nasal fracture, and swelling of the brain. Witnesses reported that several fights broke out in the area and somehow the victim became involved in one after a male allegedly punched his girlfriend. It was described that approximately ten people were striking the victim and then one male struck the victim in the head with a glass bottle, knocking him to the ground, where others began to kick and stomp him. The suspect that struck the victim with the bottle is described as a white male in his 20's, 6'00" tall, 145 lbs., wearing a white tank top, blue jean shorts, very tan complexion, a chin-strap beard with "DC" shaved into right side of his head and multiple tattoos on his arms. Detectives are assisting in this investigation.
