

WEEKLY REPORT
07/31-08/06/11

On Monday, August 1st at approximately 11:49 p.m., PFC Mease was on routine patrol in the area of Creek View Road and Paper Mill Road. PFC Mease observed a vehicle parked suspiciously on city property across from Creek View Road. PFC Mease approached the vehicle and found a male and a female sleeping in the vehicle. After speaking with the subjects, it became apparent that the female was not giving proper identification. A check of the vehicle registration then showed that the vehicle was stolen out of Missouri and that the female was in fact a 15 year old runaway. The male was identified as 25 year old David Plummer of Golden City, MO. Plummer was arrested for Receiving Stolen Property, Carrying a Concealed Deadly Weapon and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. The 15 year old runaway was charged with Criminal Impersonation. The 15 year old was remanded to the New Castle County Detention Center until her parents could arrive from Missouri. Plummer was sent to Howard Young Correctional Institute in lieu of \$20,000 cash bail.

On Thursday, August 4th, at approximately 3:03 a.m., Cpl. Sharpe and Cpl. Schwagel responded to Porter Ford on Ogletown Road for a report that the night security officer had caught two males stealing used tires from the rear of the building. Sang Nguyen of Elkton, MD and Jonathan Dommert of Newark, DE were arrested for Theft and Conspiracy. The tires are piled under a large sign which reads: No Trespassing, No Tire Removal. The tires are valued at \$100 and are sold by the dealership to playground mulch companies.

On Friday, August 5th, Cpl. Marconi made contact with representatives from Wells Fargo Bank on S. College Avenue. A mistake had been made when one subject came in to the branch and deposited a \$25,000 check. The deposit was put into the wrong account. Wells Fargo conducted an investigation and learned which account the deposit went into. After their research, the owner of the account where the check was mistakenly deposited into, that person spent or withdrew all of the money. A suspect has been identified and the case has been turned over to Detective for additional investigation and arrest action.

On Sunday, August 7th, PFC Barnes responded to the Calvary Baptist Church on E. Delaware Avenue for a report of a theft. The victim reported that she had momentarily left her purse unattended in a room in the church. As the victim was walking to another area of the church, a subject came into the church to inquire about monetary assistance. The victim directed the female subject to two other church members. The victim then returned to the room where the purse was, about five minutes had passed, and noticed that the wallet was missing from the purse. The unknown female was also not in the church any longer. The female suspect was described as a unknown race female, 25 to 35 years old, 5'05 to 5'08" tall, 150 to 170 lbs., blonde hair, wearing jeans and an inside out t-shirt. This case is continuing to be investigated.
