

WEEKLY REPORT
08/07-08/13/11

The Newark Police Department is investigating an attempted robbery that occurred on Monday, August 15th at approximately 4:57pm, at the Walgreens Pharmacy located in Suburban Plaza Shopping Center. During this incident, a white male suspect approached the pharmacy counter and advised the clerk that he was armed with a bomb. The suspect demanded the clerk turn over Oxycontin, however, the clerk refused and the suspect fled out the front of the store. The area was searched by Newark Police and a Delaware State Police K9 team, however the suspect was not located. The suspect is described as a white male, approximately 5'8" to 5'10" tall with long gray hair and a dark colored goatee. He was wearing a long sleeve gray t-shirt, blue jeans, sunglasses, dark colored baseball hat and carrying a blue soft cooler.

On Tuesday, August 16th, Corporal Greg Micolucci and members of the Street Crime Unit executed a graffiti related arrest and search warrant. One suspect was arrested and charged with two counts of graffiti, 2 counts of possession of graffiti implements, and several drug charges. A second suspect was arrested and charged with several drug charges.

On Wednesday, August 17th, Officer Spadola and Officer Wolfrom were dispatched to a report of two suspicious males in the area of the Newark Transit Hub. The two suspects were located outside of a convenience store located on Delaware Avenue. While conducting their investigation, one of the suspects sprayed mace at the officers and tried to escape. Officer Spadola was able to use his taser to prevent the suspect from escaping. Officer Wolfrom was treated at the hospital and released.

The 2011 Fall Crime Suppression Plan has been implemented. On Monday, August 22nd, the University of Delaware Police Department will assign five officers to work with the Newark Street Crime Unit.
