

WEEKLY REPORT

09/18-09/24/11

On Sunday, September 25th, Cpl. Vernon responded to a residence in the first block of North Chapel Street for a report of a residential burglary. The victims reported that sometime between 11:45 p.m. on 9/24 and 2:00 a.m. 9/25, an unknown suspect entered into the residence and stole electronics valued at \$1,150. It appeared that the suspect climbed a fire escape and entered the residence through a second floor window. During this time frame there was a large party at the next door residence, where numerous subjects were observed in the yard and house. An arrest for loud music was made at that party. Evidence was recovered from the scene and the case will be turned over to detectives.

On Monday, September 26th, M/Cpl. Nelson responded to the 100 Block of South Chapel Street for a report of a trespassing in progress. Upon arrival to the address, contact was made with the victim who stated that she was awakened by a noise. The victim looked into her living room and observed an unknown male standing there. The victim then fled to the second floor of the residence and called 911. The suspect was described as a black male, 5'09" to 6'00" tall, with a heavy build, weighing approximately 250 lbs., with short hair, wearing a white zippered jacket with green sleeves and blue jeans. A K9 track and evidence work was performed at the scene. The investigation is continuing.

On Monday, September 26th, M/Cpl. Gillespie responded to the 600 block of Lehigh Road for a report that a 2 year old child had fallen out of a second floor window to the ground below. The investigation revealed that the child climbed onto a chair that was in front of a window. The window was open, but the screen was closed. The child then fell into the screen which broke loose and the child fell out the window approximately 16 feet to a grassy area below. The child was transported to the hospital by Aetna, Hose, Hook and Ladder for evaluation.

On Tuesday, September 27th, Officer Gruszecki and Cpl. Kendrick responded to the 200 block of East Main Street for a report of a vehicle fire. Officers observed that the tires and rims had been removed from the vehicle that was on fire. The fire then spread to a second vehicle which was also damaged. Aetna Hose, Hook and Ladder responded to the scene and extinguished the fire. The State Fire Marshal's Office responded to the scene to assist in the investigation.
