The Delaware State Police recently arrested a suspect for a commercial robbery in their jurisdiction. Information from that arrest lead to Newark Police Department detectives charging the suspect with a robbery that occurred on August 18, 2011 at Walgreens. Delaware State Police also supplied information to Newark Police Department that led to the arrest of a suspect for the robbery that occurred on August 27, 2011 at the 7-11 convenience store. Both suspects are currently being held at Gander Hill.

Corporal Micolucci continues to work on numerous graffiti investigations and expects to make several arrests within the next few days.

Newark detectives, with assistance from Delaware Crime Stoppers, and multiple tipsters have arrested two suspects responsible for the theft of over \$8,000 in scrap metal and power tools from a Newark business.

Corporal Darryl Saunders, Corporal Marty LaRue, Corporal Jim Marconi, Corporal Craig Maurer and PFC Adam Stevens were recently recognized as Officers of the Quarter by the Knights of Columbus for their actions on May 12, 2011 following a home invasion armed robbery that resulted in the arrest of four suspects. Cpl. Saunders was nominated for his contributions to the overall safety and security at Newark High School.

The new police recruits have completed their first two weeks of field training and are progressing on schedule.
