

WEEKLY REPORT

On Tuesday, October 18, 2011 at approximately 5:15 p.m., a call came into the 911 center that a non emergency vehicle was traveling on East Delaware Avenue and was using a siren as it was traveling down the road. M/Cpl. Nelson was able to locate the vehicle and conduct a traffic stop on Library Avenue. The driver had placed a working siren and micro phone unit in the engine compartment of the vehicle. The driver, identified as Adnan Khan, was issued summonses for a noise violation, driving while suspended, no proof of insurance, illegal use of a siren in a vehicle and improper window tint.

On Friday, October 21, 2011 at approximately 9:18 p.m., Corporal Kendrick responded to a report of a strong arm robbery on North College Avenue near Ray Street. A 20 year old female University of Delaware student was walking on North College Avenue when the incident occurred. The victim told police that while she was walking and talking on her cell phone, an unknown male came from behind and pulled her purse from her wrist and fled on foot towards Ray Street. The victim was not injured during this incident. A Newark Police K9 responded to the scene but was unable to locate the suspect. The suspect was described as a male of unknown race, wearing a black leather jacket, black pants and a black cap on his head. This case has been turned over to a detective for investigation.

On Tuesday, October 25, 2011 at approximately 4:37 a.m., Corporal Maurer and Officer Lawrence responded to the area of the 400 block of Casho Mill Drive for a report that suspects were walking around the area using baseball bats to damage property. As the officers were on this call, other reports came in that the suspects were in another neighborhood causing damage. Investigation revealed that numerous mailboxes, lamp posts, fences and sidewalk lighting had been damaged. The neighborhoods included Cherry Hill, Williamsburg Village and Abbottsford. Several victims heard the commotion and called police, describing three suspects carrying baseball bats doing the damage. Over \$2,600 in damage has been documented so far. Three suspects were taken into custody on the train tracks behind Thorn Lane carrying baseball bats. Charges for this case are pending the completion of the investigation and identification of additional victims.
