

Weekly Report  
10/23-10/29/11

On Friday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, Officer Peter Barnes stopped a vehicle that matched the description of a vehicle used in a robbery in the area of New London Road the previous week. A subsequent investigation lead to two occupants of the vehicle being charged with 2 counts of robbery and 1 count of conspiracy. The suspects were also charged with committing a robbery in Claymont.

On Friday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, members of the Street Crime Unit and the State of Delaware Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Enforcement used cooperative underage witnesses to conduct alcohol compliance checks at liquor stores, and establishments, serving alcohol in the City of Newark. Eleven establishments were checked. Four establishments were charged with serving alcohol to an underage person. The establishments that did comply with the law were notified by letter that they passed the check.

On Saturday, October 29<sup>th</sup>, Captain Williams, Lt Hargrove and other Newark Police officers staffed the "Drug Take Back Program" sponsored by the Drug Enforcement Administration at the Newark Senior Center. The officers collected over 509 pounds of unwanted drugs dropped off by members of the public.

On Friday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, Newark Police arrested a Newark resident for a burglary and theft that occurred at the Embassy Suites Hotel on September 17, 2011. The initial incident was falsely reported as an armed robbery. The robbery will be removed from the robbery column on our weekly crime report.
