

WEEKLY REPORT
11/06-11/12/11

The University of Delaware Homecoming Football game was held on Saturday, November 12th. A majority of the Newark Police Department worked during the weekend, which historically brings in a large number of calls for police service. Police call and arrest data for the weekend is still being compiled. Preliminary numbers show that over 50 arrests were made for various order maintenance violations throughout the city. A majority of the arrests were for Underage Possession/Consumption of Alcohol, Open Containers of Alcohol, Disorderly Premises, Noise Violations and Disorderly Conduct.

On November 10th, a Newark officer was waived down on East Park Place for a report of two subjects possibly trying to break into homes. Officers in the area were able to locate the pair. Through investigation it was learned that the two subjects went up to the door of a residence and tried to enter the front door. When unsuccessful, the two went to a neighboring house and tried to enter that house. An alert resident saw the two and waived down the officer. Arrested were Geoffrey Amsler, white male, DOB 07/17/80 and Jennifer Kallaur, white female, DOB 12/14/83. They were charged with Trespassing, Conspiracy and other related charges.

The Newark Police Department is currently investigating an attempted sexual assault which occurred on Tuesday, November 13th at approximately 9 p.m. in a field adjacent to the James F. Hall Trail in Phillips Park. The victim, who is new to the area, reported that she walked from her residence to the 7-11 on Elkton Road. After exiting the store she was confused on how to get back to her residence and while standing in front of the store was approached by the suspect who initiated conversation with her. The suspect then offered to show her the way back to her residence. The victim then walked with the suspect until the two ended up on the James F. Hall Trail adjacent to Phillips Park. The victim became suspicious of the male at this time and turned around to leave. When she turned to leave the male grabbed her and knocked her to the ground where he proceeded and attempted to remove her clothing. The victim was able to fight off the male suspect and fled on foot to a residence on Apple Road where she reported the incident to the homeowner. Through investigation, the Newark Police Department identified the suspect in the attempted sexual assault that occurred during the evening of November 13th as Marvin M. Holmes (DOB 12/19/69). An arrest warrant for Holmes has been obtained charging him with Attempted Rape Second Degree and Strangulation. The Newark Police Department is actively searching for Holmes who is known to frequent residences and businesses located along Elkton Road in Newark. Holmes is known to use the names "Nico", "Rick" and "Mar".
