**SUBJECT: Newark Police Attempting to Identify Fraud Suspect**

The Newark Police are attempting to identify a subject involved in an attempted fraud at the PNC Bank located at 230 East Main Street. On November 21<sup>st</sup>, at approximately 4:55pm the subject presented a fictitious New Jersey Drivers License in the name of a PNC account holder and attempted to withdraw money from the customer's account. The teller recognized the license as fictitious and bank personnel contacted the police. The subject fled the bank prior to police arrival.
