On Tuesday, December 13<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 p.m., a female walked into the Formal Affairs store on Main Street and removed \$166.00 from the cash register. An employee followed the woman and called her description into the police department. The woman was stopped by officers a few minutes later and arrested. She was charged with theft, as well as criminal impersonation. The suspect also admitted to a similar offense at the same business last month. She was also found to have numerous outstanding arrest warrants. The suspect was held on \$6,500 bail.

The Newark Police Department continues to investigate an increase in residential burglaries as well as thefts from motor vehicles. Several suspects have been arrested and charged for these crimes but it appears there are several unrelated suspects committing these offenses. Residents are encouraged to report any suspicious activity to the police immediately. Home security tips are available by visiting the City of Newark website.

Last week the Newark Street Crime Unit and State of Delaware Division of Alcohol Enforcement conducted a second round of alcohol compliance checks at liquor stores, bars, and restaurants within the City of Newark. Cooperating underage witnesses were sent into each establishment in an attempt to purchase alcohol. Seven businesses sold alcohol to the underage witness. The Street Crime Officers criminally charged the individuals while DATE Agents handled the administrative sanctions. A letter was sent to all establishments that passes the check and refused to sell alcohol to the underage witness. Compliance checks will continue to be scheduled in the future.
