

WEEKLY REPORT

On January 3rd, 2012 Charles Hymer of Newark was arrested for a December 14th residential burglary in the unit block of Thompson Circle. Hymer was connected to this burglary after he was stopped by the Elkton Police Department on December 15th, 2011 for an unrelated incident. During this stop, he was found in possession of stolen property linking him to the Thompson Circle burglary. Charles Hymer DOB 02/01/86, of 43 Thompson Circle, Newark, DE 19711, was arrested and charged with Burglary 2nd Degree, Theft over \$1500 and Criminal Mischief under \$1000. Hymer was committed to Howard R. Young Correctional in lieu of \$3,250 bail.

On January 3rd, 2012 John T. Steinbeiser of Newark was arrested following a lengthy Burglary investigation. Steinbeiser was connected to five residential daytime burglaries which occurred in the neighborhood of Ridgewood Glen between September and December, 2011. John T. Steinbeiser DOB 07/19/79, formerly of 53 Shenandoah Drive, Newark, DE 19711, was arrested and charged with 5 counts of Burglary 2nd Degree, 5 counts of Theft over \$1500 and 3 counts Criminal Mischief under \$1000. Steinbeiser was committed to Howard R. Young Correctional in lieu of \$7,800 bail.

On January 6th, 2012 the Newark Police Department arrested Robert Groski and Anthony Gatta, both of Newark, for their involvement in two recent residential daytime burglaries in the Hunt at Louviers neighborhood. The first burglary occurred on September 8th, 2011 and the second occurred on November 7th, 2011. Groski and Gatta were previously apprehended by a New Castle County Police K9 team while fleeing from a daytime burglary on December 1st, 2011. Following that apprehension the pair was arrested by NCCPD and NPD for several burglaries and was later linked to the two above incidents. Arrested were Robert Groski DOB 05/22/1992, of 13 Holt Road, Newark, DE 19711, and Anthony Gatta DOB 07/08/1993 of 192 Esmer Court, Newark, DE 19711. Both were charged with 2 Counts Burglary 2nd Degree, 3 Counts Theft over \$1500, 2 Counts Conspiracy 2nd Degree, and 1 Count Criminal Mischief under \$1000. Both were released on \$7,250 unsecured bond.

On January 8th, 2012 at approximately 4:45 am the night clerk at the Howard Johnson's Hotel was approached in the lobby by a female subject, wearing a mask partially concealing her face. The suspect was armed with a knife and demanded the clerk unlock the cash drawer. A struggle ensued, during which, the clerk was cut several times. The suspect then removed an undisclosed amount of currency from the cash drawer and fled the office. The clerk recognized the suspect as a guest at the hotel and responding officers were able to locate her and a second suspect in a room at the hotel. Evidence was located linking the pair to the crime and both were taken into custody without incident. The clerk, a 22 year old male from Newark, sustained a laceration to his hand and shoulder. He was transported to Christiana Hospital where he was treated for his injuries and released. Arrested was Samantha Townsend DOB 11/12/92, of 849

Broadfield Drive Newark, DE 19713, and Barbara Filer-Epps DOB 6/27/91, of 7 Blue Hen Ridge Newark, DE 19711. Both were charged with Robbery 1st Degree, Possession of Deadly Weapon During The Commission of Felony, Assault 2nd Degree, Wearing a Disguise During Commission of Felony and Conspiracy 2nd Degree. Both were committed to Baylor Women's Correctional on \$65,500 secured bail.

On January 9th, 2012 at approximately 8:30am a resident reported hearing a loud crashing sound in the 500 block of Cambridge Drive. The resident then observed a suspicious male subject hiding in the bushes in the rear of a neighboring residence. After reporting the incident to the police, the resident chased the subject who fled on foot and was last seen in the area of 115 Locust Drive. A second resident also contacted police reporting that a subject, known to the resident as Hooks, had just run through the rear yards of Cambridge Drive. Responding officers discovered that a sliding glass door in the rear of the residence, where Hooks had been seen hiding, had been broken out. Officers located Hooks at his residence and took him into custody. Arrested was Bradley M. Hooks DOB 11/08/1991, of 115 Locust Drive, Newark, DE 19711. He was charged with 1 Count Attempted Burglary 2nd Degree, 1 Count Criminal Mischief Under \$1000, 1 Count Criminal Trespass, and 1 Count of Conspiracy. He was released on \$3,850 unsecured bail.
