SUBJECT: Crime Alert – Theft from Vehicles and Sheds

The Newark Police Department is investigating 12 weekend incidents of theft from unsecured vehicles, sheds and yards in the community of Nottingham Green. In all instances, entry was gained through unsecured shed or vehicle doors. After gaining entry, the suspect(s) removed items including a power generator, snow blower, gasoline, hunting equipment, several wallets, a digital camera, CD's and loose change. In total over \$6,000 in property was stolen.

The thefts occurred in the overnight hours from Friday 1/20/12 into Saturday 1/21/12.

Locations and times of occurrences are:

700 Block Bent Lane – 4 vehicles, 3 sheds

700 Block Colgate Lane – 2 vehicles

400 Block Radcliffe Drive – 2 Vehicles

700 Block of Harvard Lane – 1 Shed

There are no known suspects at this time. Residents are urged to secure their sheds, vehicles and homes and are cautioned to be alert for suspicious persons and vehicles. If suspicious activity is observed residents should call the police immediately.
