

WEEKLY REPORT

On Thursday, February 23rd, at 4:09 a.m., a passenger car drove onto the CSX railroad tracks near the intersection of West Main Street and New London Road. The car was heading northbound on New London Road and turned left onto the train tracks causing the vehicle to become stuck on the tracks. Two passer-bys noticed the car stuck on the tracks and stopped to assist. As the pedestrians and the two occupants of the car attempted to push the car from the tracks, the train gates activated and they heard the sound of a train approaching. The group left the tracks and the car was subsequently struck by the train. No one was injured. Interim City Manager Carol Houck, Chief Tiernan, and Lt. Stanko will be meeting with DELDOT and CSX to discuss this and previous accidents at this location.

On Tuesday, February 28th, Cpl. Darryl Saunders was conducting truancy patrol. He observed a Newark High School truant at the College Square Shopping Center. The student was arrested for possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia.

Lt. Brian Henry has submitted and been approved for two grants. The Newark Police Department will receive \$9,139.60 from the State of Delaware for drug investigation overtime as well as \$27,660.65 to purchase two additional in-car cameras with associated digital storage equipment.

On Thursday, March 1st, Chief Tiernan and Captain Williams travelled to North Bergen, New Jersey for a demonstration of brand new CCTV light technology. This system allows police personnel, monitoring a CCTV system to immediately beam a light with the words "POLICE RESPONDING" to an active incident such as a robbery or a fight in progress.
