**Newark introduces new hybrid vehicles for its city fleet**

**WHAT:** Newark will introduce three new hybrid vehicles to the city's fleet. A Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI) Greenhouse Gas Reductions Project grant, administered by the DNREC Division of Energy and Climate, partially funded the cost of three Toyota Camry sedans to be used in the city's Parks and Recreation Department and Electric Department. The addition of the hybrid vehicles to the fleet will help offset the rising cost of fuel for a standard gasoline-powered vehicle and contribute to cleaner air and reduced carbon emissions.
