

WEEKLY REPORT
04/01-04/07/12

On Wednesday, April 4, 2012, the Newark Police Department arrested 23 year-old Christopher Kramer and 23 year-old Matthew Miller, both of Newark, following an armed robbery of the Walgreens Pharmacy located in Suburban Plaza Shopping Center.

At approximately 1:00 p.m. on April 4th, Newark Police officers responded to a report that the pharmacy had just been robbed by a man armed with a knife and wearing a scarf over his face. Responding officers learned that the suspect had jumped the pharmacy counter, displayed a knife and demanded prescription drugs from the pharmacist. After obtaining a quantity of prescription drugs the suspect fled on foot to the wooded area behind the shopping center. Responding officers located the suspect, later identified as Christopher Kramer, as he fled on foot through an adjacent apartment complex. Following a brief foot chase officers apprehended Kramer who was still in possession of the drugs. No one was injured during the robbery.

While investigating the robbery, officers were alerted that a shoplifting incident had occurred in the store shortly after the robbery. The suspect, identified as Matthew Miller, was observed concealing candy in a duffle bag and then exiting the store. He was taken into custody by officers after he entered into another store in the shopping center. Investigators determined that Miller had entered into the pharmacy with Kramer and was serving as a lookout while Kramer committed the robbery. Miller remained in the pharmacy posing as a customer when Kramer fled.

The Newark Police Department and the Delaware Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Enforcement continue to work on addressing recent assaults in and around establishments that serve alcohol.

Planning continues for Cinco de Mayo weekend with coordination and planning between the Newark Police Department, Delaware Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Enforcement and the University of Delaware Police. Additional Newark Police Officers will be working throughout the weekend.
