The Newark Police Department is investigating a burglary which occurred on May 20, 2012 at approximately 5:30 a.m. at the Applebees Restaurant located in Suburban Plaza Shopping Center. During this incident a white male suspect gained entry to the closed restaurant, and once inside, removed a safe containing an undisclosed amount of US currency.

The suspect is described as a white male approximately 6' tall with brown hair. The suspect is wearing a grey short sleeve shirt, blue jeans, dark shoes and black gloves. It is believed the suspect fled the scene in a dark colored two door vehicle.
