On Sunday, May 27<sup>th</sup> at 2:04 p.m., Cpl. Walker responded to the Sears Store in College Square on a report of a shoplifter. Employees stated they observed a man walk out of the store with a Craftsman chainsaw valued at \$259.99. The suspect entered a vehicle in the parking lot and drove off.

At 3:19 p.m., employees at the Home Depot Store located in Suburban Plaza reported that a man walked out of the store with a pressure washer valued at \$399.00. The suspect jumped into a vehicle and drove off. In both the Sears and the Home Depot incidents, the employees were able to provide the registration number of the vehicle and the suspects have been identified.

On Wednesday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, the second and last rounds of interviews were conducted for the police promotional process. Officers were interviewed by a promotional board which consisted of Chief Tobin of Middletown, Chief McDerby of New Castle City and Charles Zusag. The promotional candidates had previously taken a written exam and were assigned a "Chief's rating" score. The total scores from the exam, Chief's rating, and the interview board will be combined to rank the candidates.

On Thursday, May 31<sup>st</sup> and Friday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, Chief Tiernan and other community members viewed the year end projects of Ms. Staci Garber's freshmen class at Newark High School. The projects dealt with such topics as Obesity, Violent Crime, Domestic Violence, Drug Use, Racism as well as other topics.

Numerous officers will be working traffic and security posts at Newark Day this Saturday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>. As usual the police command post will be set up in front of Catherine Rooney's.
