

WEEKLY REPORT

06/24/12-06/30/12

Since June 27, 2012, there have been approximately 15 reported burglaries of vehicles in the Stafford area of the City. The juvenile suspects gained entry into unsecured vehicles and tampered with the contents, often removing cash or loose belongings. In several cases, the victims left their vehicle's spare keys within the vehicle; including one case in which the juvenile suspects stole the vehicle, crashed almost immediately and fled the scene on foot.

Suspects have been identified and a search of 2 residences resulted in the recovery of stolen property, including additional keys for vehicles. Two suspects confessed to their involvement in the recent crime spree. Additionally, the offenders confessed to theft from a porch and neighborhood harassment/vandalism. Criminal complaints/warrants will be sought for the juvenile offenders.

The Newark Police Department is investigating the armed robbery of the PNC Bank branch located at 425 New London Road. The incident occurred on Friday, June 29th at approximately 5:47 p.m. The defendant confronted three bank tellers near the close of business brandishing a firearm while demanding cash. After receiving the cash, the suspect fled on foot. A description of the defendant was provided by bank employees and was broadcasted over police radio. The defendant was located operating a motor vehicle on Possum Park Road. When the defendant was stopped in traffic he was approached by three police officers (2 NPD officers and 1 DSP officer). The defendant was given verbal commands which he disregarded driving over a concrete median, striking a Newark Officer and fleeing leading officers on a vehicle pursuit. The defendant was apprehended in the North Star area in the back yard of a residence on West Meadow Lane after he abandoned his vehicle. A substantial amount of cash and a firearm was recovered. Note: The PNC bank employees were unharmed, and the Newark police Officer was treated and released from Christiana Hospital with a foot injury.
