Following a tip from Delaware Crime Stoppers, Newark Police arrested two suspects for the July 10<sup>th</sup> armed robbery at Cigarette City in College Square Shopping Center. Further investigation revealed that the suspects were responsible for several other robberies in Delaware State Police jurisdiction.

The Newark Police promotion ceremony was held on Friday, July 13<sup>th</sup> for Lieutenant Kevin Feeney, Sergeant Curtis Davis and Master Corporal Michael Szep. The event was well attended by officers, family, and friends. Also attending was Mayor Vance Funk, Councilman Jerry Clifton and Councilman Stu Markham.
