The Newark Police Department is investigating five recent residential burglaries that have occurred in the downtown area.

At the Newark City Council meeting on Monday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>, Newark High School Nurse, Lori Economos and Corporal Darryl Saunders were presented with a proclamation for their life saving actions. Ms. Economos and Cpl. Saunders performed CPR on a high school student who had stopped breathing. The student was resuscitated and graduated from the high school this past June.

On Thursday, July 26<sup>th</sup>, Chief Tiernan met with the supervisors of the Street Crime Unit and Special Operations Unit to plan for the upcoming 2012 Fall Crime Suppression Operation. A meeting with Newark Patrol Supervisors will be held next week. A final meeting will be held with representatives from the University of Delaware Police Department prior to beginning the operation. Currently, the Newark Police Department has one vacant police officer position, two officers on light duty and one officer out for an on the job injury. Part of the planning process will involve lessening the impact created by these four vacant street positions.

On Tuesday, July 31<sup>st</sup>, the second of three mandated firearm qualifications will be completed. The final round of qualifications will take place in the late fall.
